On July 10, 2019, the newly formed committee met in the principal's office. Dr. Anil V, the principal, Ms. Sheeja K S, a member of the teaching staff, and Ms. Usha K V, an administrative staff member, were the other members of the committee. In addition to reviewing the admission data obtained from the office, the committee members decided to provide extra help in areas where OBC (Other Backward Class) students encounter difficulties.

They provided personal counseling to students to help them adapt to campus activities and build their confidence. The cell members also checked the admission and scholarship registers to ensure that the reservation quota for OBC students was observed during admission. Additionally, students from economically backward OBC groups were able to avail of E-Grants scholarships.

The second meeting of the committee was held on March 02, 2020. During the meeting, the members reviewed the admission and scholarship registers to ensure that the reservation quota for OBC (Other Backward Classes) students was followed during admissions and that the scholarships owed to them were distributed. Ms. Jini Kuriakose, Assistant Professor in the PG Department of Commerce, was assigned as the teaching staff member responsible for scholarships. Ms. Usha, the office staff member responsible for scholarships, was assigned the task of following up on the scholarship details for the OBC students. There were no grievances

reported by OBC students regarding any inconveniences they experienced at the college during the academic year.

2020-21

The OBC Cell was established for the academic year 2020-21 with four members: the Principal, Dr. Rajimol M.S, Mr. Basheer K K, the Coordinator, Ms.Prasanna A.C. Assistant Professor, PG Department of Commerce, the teaching staff member, and Mr. Muhammed Zakkir, an administrative staff member. The first-term meeting took place online on August 1st, 2020.

The members received proper guidance on how to connect with OBC students during online education to safeguard the students' interests. It was decided to share details about available scholarships for OBC students via class WhatsApp groups. Online sessions to raise awareness about scholarships and orientation for first-year students were organized. Ms. Nisha K.V. conducted the session, providing instructions on how to apply for E-Grants. Additionally, the tutors of each class were responsible for monitoring the scholarships accessed by the students.

The second-term meeting of the Cell was held via Google Meet on March 5, 2021. During the meeting, the members reviewed the admission and scholarship registers to ensure that the reservation quota for OBC students was followed during admissions and that the scholarships due to them were distributed. Ms. Nisha K.V, Assistant Professor of Commerce, was designated as the teaching staff in charge of scholarships. From the details shared by Ms. Nisha K.V, it was learned that all the OBC students eligible for concessions and scholarships received benefits during the year. No grievances were reported by OBC students regarding any inconveniences they experienced at the college during the academic year.
