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ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON ALUMNI FEEDBACK



ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

For the academic year 2021-22, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at NMSM Government College Kalpetta sought feedback from alumni, which played a crucial role in shaping the institution's strategic actions. The college used this feedback to strengthen key areas, such as faculty development, digital infrastructure, and the expansion of student support services.

The college's commitment to improving teaching quality was evident in the organization of several Faculty Development Programs (FDPs). Alumni noted the positive impact of these initiatives, which introduced modern pedagogical practices aimed at enhancing the academic experience for current students. Faculty members participated in workshops on online teaching, curriculum redesign, and the implementation of Outcome-Based Education (OBE). Moreover, sessions on digital literacy and hybrid teaching were included.

Digital infrastructure was another area of focus, and alumni were pleased to see the expansion of the Online Education Support Centre (OESC). This initiative provided students from economically weak backgrounds with access to gadgets and devices essential for online learning. In addition, the addition of new smart classrooms facilitated the integration of ICT tools in daily teaching, helping students stay ahead in an increasingly digital academic world.

E-governance systems were significantly improved, with the introduction of an online attendance and assessment system. This system allowed both students and teachers to monitor academic performance in real-time. The college also digitized its financial transactions system, improving transparency and efficiency in handling student-related financial matters.

The expansion of the scholarship program was another noteworthy development. The college extended its support to a broader range of socio-economically disadvantaged students, ensuring that 95.04% of the student body benefited from financial aid. This demonstrated the institution's ongoing commitment to providing equal opportunities for all students, a value that alumni strongly supported.



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
