ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-21

To further enhance the academic environment, the college prioritized faculty development through regular Faculty Development Programs (FDPs). Research initiatives were also expanded, with students being encouraged to actively participate in collaborative research projects alongside faculty members. This not only enriched the students' academic experience but also provided them with valuable insights into advanced research practices
