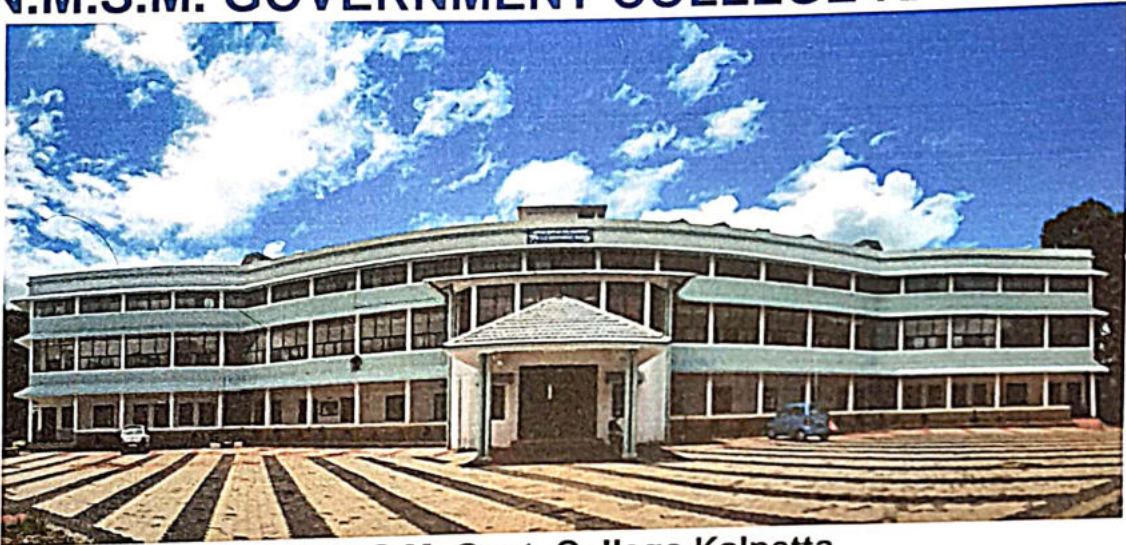

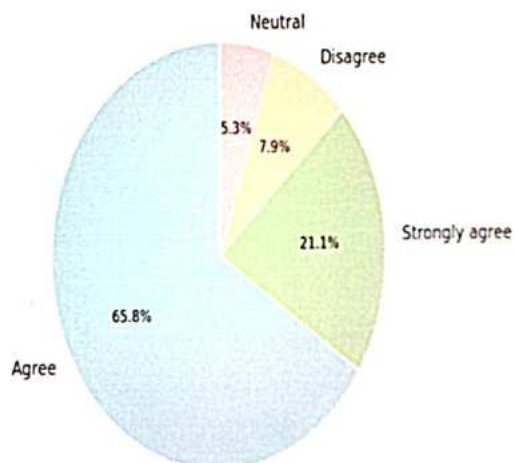
In the academic year 2023-24, feedback from teachers were collected by means of Google form. The analysis of the survey is given below:

Percentage distribution of responses for 1 Suitable syllabus to the course



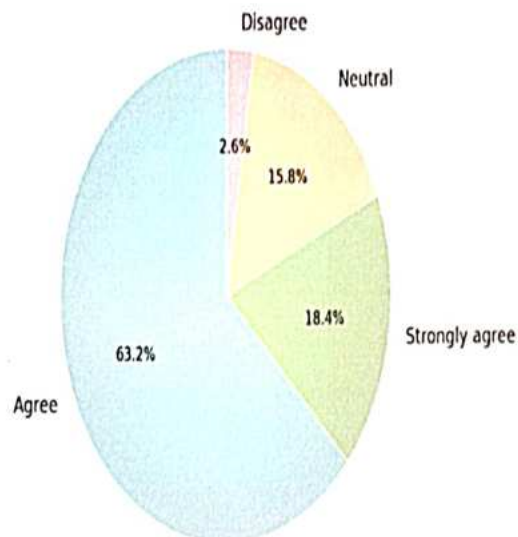
Interpretation

Percentage distribution of responses for 2 Need based syllabus



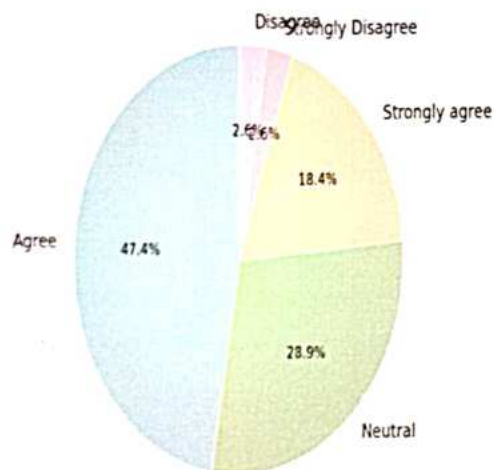

Percentage distribution of responses for 3Employability of curriculum



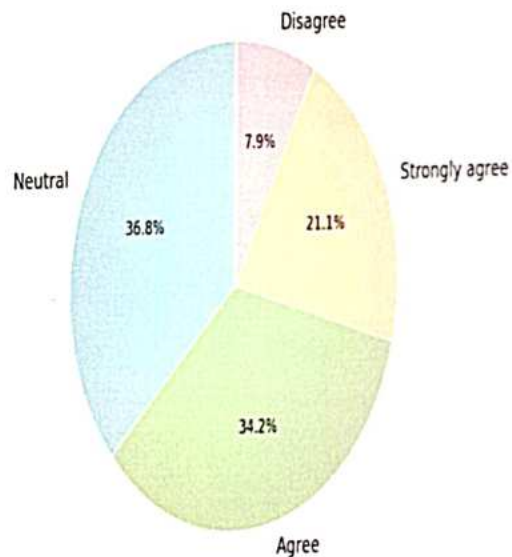

Percentage distribution of responses for 4 Learner centric Curriculum



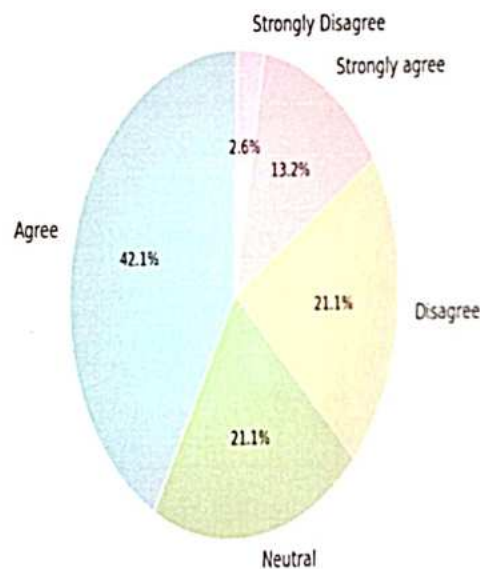

Percentage distribution of responses for 5 Time bound manageability of the syllabus



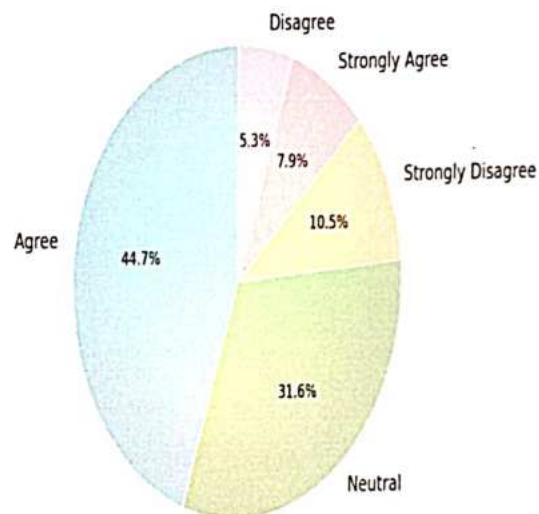

Percentage distribution of responses for 6 Freedom to adopt new techniques of teaching



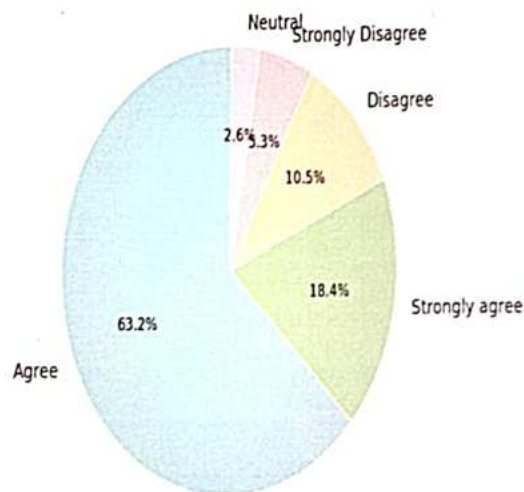

Percentage distribution of responses for 7Availability of sufficient numbers of prescribed books in



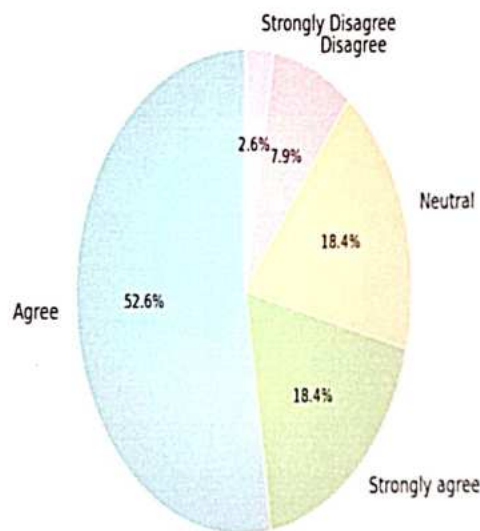

Figure 1: Distribution of responses for 8 Facilities like class rooms, toilet, auditorium, internet/ photo copier etc



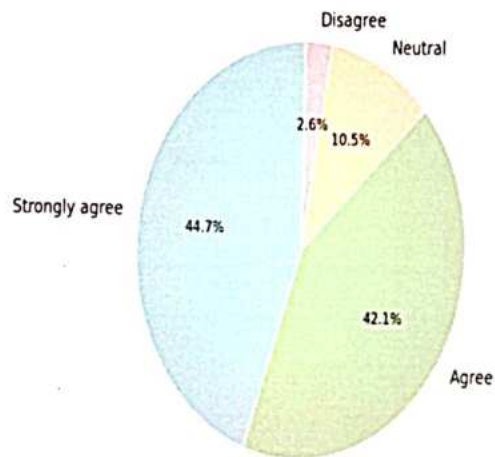

Percentage distribution of responses for 9 Teacher friendly administration



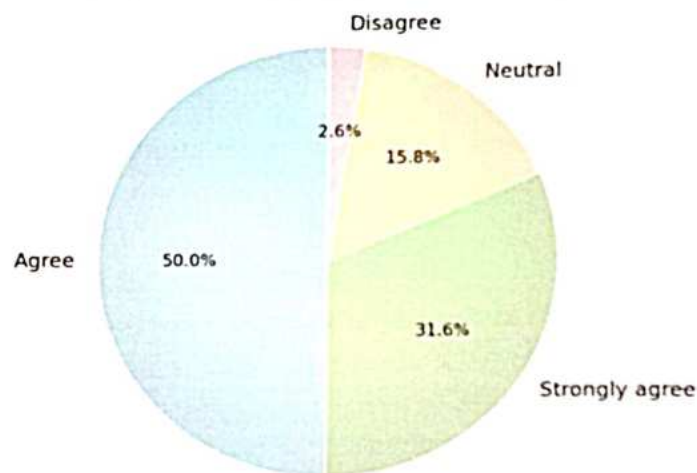

Percentage distribution of responses for 10Excellent learning atmosphere in the college

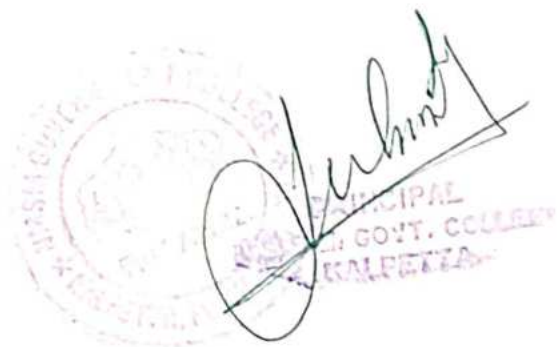


Interpretation

Valuable suggestions

4. Each Department should ensure effective learner participation in the process of learning. Conducting model examinations in the University pattern can help students to get familiar with exam patterns .It should not be the necessity of any one or two departments.
5. All the facilities should not be sent to the valuation camp, suspending the classes. A certain percentage should be retained so as to conduct the classes.
6. Learning process can be made more effective if we are provided with sufficient classrooms.
7. Improve Infrastructure
8. Reduce heavy clerical works of teachers
9. The college would need to have more programmes in diverse academic disciplines so as to have more interdisciplinary academic engagements.
10. To provide a first-rate learning environment, more infrastructure is required.
11. Take measures to Increase the number of programmes
12. Adoption of Student centric Pedagogical supportive curriculum based on scaffolding.
