Overview of College Activities

UG Cable Work

This year, we successfully completed the installation of a modern UG (Underground) cable system. This upgrade has significantly improved the electrical infrastructure across the campus, ensuring a stable and reliable power supply essential for all academic and extracurricular activities.

CCTV Network Installation

In our commitment to enhancing campus security, the PTA supported the installation of a comprehensive CCTV network. Strategically placed cameras throughout the campus now provide 24/7 surveillance, ensuring a safer environment for students, staff, and visitors.

Campus Cleaning Initiatives

We launched several campus cleaning drives in collaboration with student volunteers. These initiatives not only beautified the college grounds but also fostered a sense of community and responsibility among students. Regular cleaning schedules have been established to maintain a clean and healthy campus environment.

Media Studio Renovation

The PTA provided substantial financial assistance for the renovation of the media studio. This state-of-the-art facility now boasts modern equipment and an updated layout, enhancing the learning experience for students in the Journalism and Mass Communication Department.

College Garden Maintenance

Our college garden received significant attention this year. With the PTA's support, we were able to enhance the landscaping, add new plant varieties, and improve the overall aesthetic appeal of the garden. This space now serves as a serene environment for relaxation and study.

Common IT Facilitation Centre

A major milestone this year was the reopening of the Common IT Facilitation Centre with lab assistant. This facility provides students with access to computers and high-speed internet, essential for research and academic work. The centre has been a valuable resource for students, particularly those without personal access to digital tools.

Support for Sports Students

In recognition of our sports students' dedication and achievements, the PTA provided additional care and support, including enhanced training facilities, nutritional guidance, and financial assistance for participation in competitions. The PTA also organized a reception to honor the college's fencing team, which had won a prize in a university competition. This support has been instrumental in fostering our athletes' growth and success.

College Union and Cultural Events

The PTA was proud to support the College Union's activities, including the inauguration, Fine Arts Day, and College Day celebrations. Financial assistance was provided to ensure these events were vibrant and memorable, showcasing the diverse talents of our student body.

New Internet Connection for the New Block and Language Department

Petitions and Demands

Other Activities:

The PTA installed CCTV cameras and conducted timely maintenance of cameras, computers, printers, and UPS systems in various departments and offices. They also covered expenses such as electricity bills, telephone bills, and affiliation fees to the university by utilizing the PTA fund.
